

# The Lord's Passover

# *New Testament Passover*

- Abib 14 (Tuesday evening)
  - Jesus celebrates the Passover Meal with his disciples
  - Betrayed and arrested during the night
- Abib 14 (Wednesday)
  - The Passover day and also a day of preparation for the High Sabbath
  - Jesus convicted by Pilot
  - Crucified at around 9am and died at around 3pm

# *New Testament Passover (cont'd)*

- Abib 15 (Thursday)
  - First Day of Unleavened Bread,
  - An annual Sabbath → everyone is at rest
- Abib 16 (Friday)
  - Regular working day
  - Preparation day for the weekly Sabbath

# *New Testament Passover (cont'd)*

- Abib 17 (Saturday)
  - Weekly Sabbath
- Abib 18 (Sunday)
  - Wave Sheaf Offering (Christ already resurrected)

# *Exodus Passover*

- Abib 14 (beginning of the day, at evening)
  - Israelites would kill the Passover lamb
  - Applied the blood to the door post and lintel
- Abib 14 (nighttime)
  - Death angel passes by, killing all the firstborns

# *Exodus Passover (cont'd)*

- Abib 14 (morning)
  - No time to prepare bread because they had to go
  - Burned the leftover lamb
  - Plundered the Egyptians on their way out
- Abib 15 (beginning of the day at evening)
  - Israelites begin their march during the night

# *Abram's Passover*

- Abib 14 (beginning of the day at evening)
  - Abram and Melchizedek partake of bread and wine
- Abib 14 (night)
  - Abram's receives vision and promise from God

# *Abram's Passover (cont'd)*

- Abib 14 (day)
  - Abram prepares sacrifices
  - Great horror and darkness falls on Abram
- Abib 15 (evening)
  - Beginning of the First Day of Unleavened Bread
  - Sacrifices are completely consumed by God
